

Replacing the configurator drivers with the Zadig tool

Zadig is a free tool that allows you to change the associated driver of connected USB devices. The tool can be downloaded at:

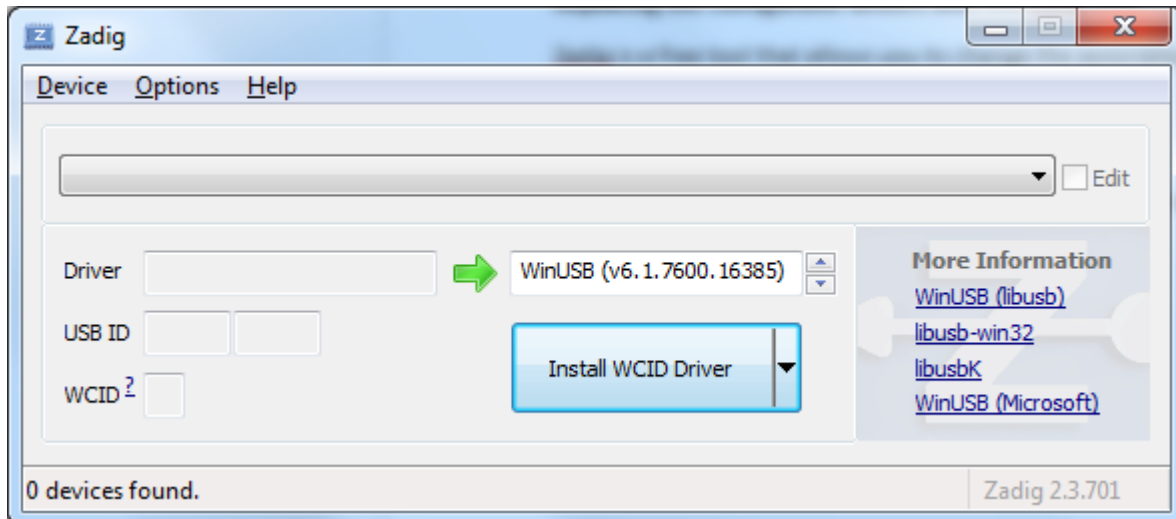


Figure 1: Zadig

Once downloaded you can open Zadig without installation, opening the software you should see a window like in Figure 1 (Note that you need admin privileges to change the driver).

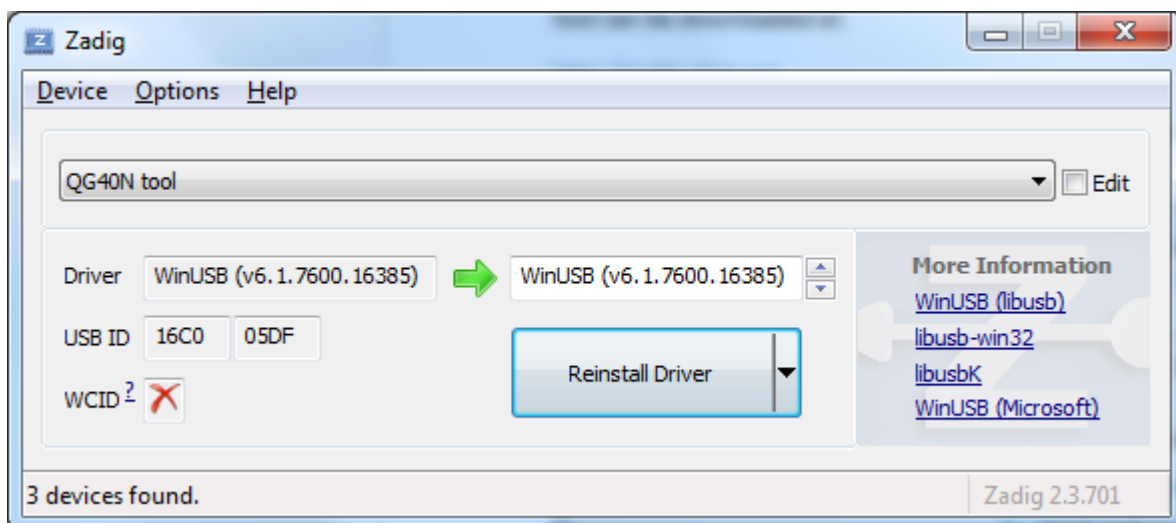


Figure 2: Select the configurator tool

To see the configurator dongle in the device listing you click “Options” and then “List all devices”. Select the “QG40N tool” from the devices. The window should now look like Figure 2 with the exception of the left “Driver” label being different (e.g. libUSB or HID). Now select the winUSB(v6.1.7600.16385) option from the choices in the list right of the green arrow. Click “Reinstall Driver” to overwrite the current driver of the configurator dongle, this may take a few minutes. After the installation is complete close Zadig, the configurator tool should now be usable with the application.
